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

#### WHAT IS DIRECT SCHOOL ADMISSION (DSA-Sec)?

DSA-Sec provides all Primary 6 students with an opportunity to go into a secondary school, based on their non-academic achievements and talents. There are different DSA-Sec Categories e.g CCAs, Talent-specific.

- DSA-Sec allows students to grow their talents through the school programmes offered.
- Each participating school offers distinctive programme and sets its own selection process and criteria to admit students with talents that can be further developed by their programmes.





 You may consider applying for your child a secondary school through DSA-Sec if you are able to identify a school that offers a talent development programme to help develop your child's area of strength. E.g In his/her current CCA

• If not, your child can participate in the Sec One Posting Exercise after the PSLE results release and be admitted to a secondary school based on his/her PSLE results.





#### **DSA Schools Selection**

When selecting a DSA-Sec school, consider the following:

Schools with talent areas that match the child's:

- strengths and interests
- pace of learning
- overall range of programmes offered by the school.







You can apply for DSA-Sec based on a wide-range of talents, including:

- Sports and games
- Visual, literary and performing arts
- Debate and public speaking
- Science, mathematics and engineering
- Languages and humanities
- Uniformed groups
- Leadership (for example, prefects, CCA leaders)



#### **DSA-SEC APPLICATION PROCESS**



- Parents are to <u>submit the application online</u> via the <u>DSA-Sec Portal between May to June</u>. Either parent may log in using SingPass to submit an application. If parents are unable to apply online, you may approach the school for assistance.
- If your child is interested in School of the Arts (SOTA) or Singapore Sports School (SSP), you should <u>apply directly</u> to the school based on the school's application timeline.
- You may visit the school's website for more information. You can indicate up to three choices during the application.
- There is no need to submit additional hardcopy testimonials and documents via the DSA-Sec Portal as the primary school information will be shared with the secondary schools that your child has applied to.








#### APPLICATION OUTCOMES

- You will be informed of the application outcome of your child by the individual schools by September. If your child have a Confirmed Offer (CO) or a Wait List (WL) offer, you will receive notification on the School Preference Submission in October.
- To gain admission, your child still need to attain PSLE results that qualify them for a course (i.e. Express, Normal (Academic) or Normal (Technical)) offered by the school.
- If your child has not been given a place in the DSA-Sec school, your child can still apply for a school through the Sec One Posting using his/her PSLE results.



### Important points to note on DSA-Sec

- Students successfully allocated to their DSA-Sec schools will NOT be allowed to participate in the S1 Posting to opt for secondary schools.
- Students will also NOT be allowed to transfer to another school after the release of their PSLE results.
- If your child is not ready to commit, he/she should participate in the S1 Posting Exercise after the release of PSLE results.






- Teachers will share with the students the interview skills needed for the E-interviews.
